Description			
<i>Provide a short description of the event and its activities.</i>			
<p>The event of RECup, titled "From Inclusion to Activation (1st Circle)," was held from 8-9 of November 2023, in Bucharest, Romania. The event aimed to foster intercultural dialogue, exchange knowledge and experiences, and explore innovative active citizenship initiatives. Participants from Romania, Croatia, and Italy gathered for a comprehensive training activity designed to strengthen European citizenship through civic and democratic participation.</p> <p>On the first day, attendees arrived in the morning and were greeted with a warm welcome. Facilitators introduced the project and its objectives, the training objectives and acknowledged the diverse backgrounds of the participants. An interactive icebreaker session followed, allowing participants to get acquainted and share their expectations for the event.</p>			

After a coffee break, the first training session began, focusing on intercultural dialogue. Participants discussed the significance of intercultural communication in community initiatives, analyzed case studies of successful collaborations, and engaged in group activities to enhance cross-cultural understanding. The second session explored innovative approaches to community engagement, where participants brainstormed ideas for citizen-led initiatives and discussed potential challenges in implementing these ideas.

A lunch break featuring Romanian cuisine provided an opportunity for networking and informal discussions. The third session involved a panel discussion with representatives from various target groups, including unemployed citizens, stakeholders, and community groups. This session allowed for the sharing of perspectives and included a Q&A segment with the panelists. The fourth session focused on capacity-building workshops, which addressed skills development, resource mobilization, and communication techniques for effective community leadership.

The day concluded with an action planning session, where participants developed actionable plans for their initiatives and received peer feedback to refine their strategies. The day ended with a summary of key takeaways, announcements for the following day, and a networking dinner to foster deeper connections among participants.

On the second day, participants began with a recap of the previous day's discussions before embarking on a city tour of Bucharest, exploring the cultural and historical aspects of the city. The event concluded with a closing ceremony, where participant groups presented their action plans and commitments. Facilitators and organizers expressed their appreciation, and participants exchanged contact information, committing to continue the dialogue beyond the training. The event officially ended with a farewell lunch, marking the successful completion of the training activity.
